

## Manchester - Change in population and ethnic structure

### POPULATION STRUCTURE

- Manchester has a young and ethnically diverse population . One of the fastest growing cities in the UK over this decade. High population densities.
- 2015 population was 510,000. Average age is 33.
- Significant increase in the population between 2001 and 2011, mostly young migrants looking for job opportunities, and some relocating from the south east.
- Highest growth amongst working age (20-25 due to migration there for work), but overall there is a low birth

### ETHNIC DIVERSITY :

#### **Diversity has significantly increase between 1991 and 2001, and 2011**

- Non-white people account for 33% of people in 2011, up from 19% in 2001.
- Black ethnic group has seen the largest increase by 273%, Settled in Mosside
- Largest ethnic group is the Pakistani, African and Chinese group.
- Pakistani communities especially located in Rusholme and Longsite


