Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to share with all students and parents our uniform expectations and ask for your support in ensuring that these are followed strictly for the start of the new academic year in September.

Uniform

Please see below in the picture opposite of our uniform expectations, which are published each year in the student planners.

PE kit

Our PE kit includes a top, shorts and socks, along with tracksuit bottoms and an outdoor waterproof. The top, shorts and socks are compulsory items, whilst the tracksuit bottoms and waterproof are optional but cannot be replaced with other items, therefore if your child wishes to wear tracksuit bottoms or a jacket during their PE lesson it must be the branded items.

Our school uniform can be purchased from either Top Marks Schoolwear in Ashton-Under-Lyne or Simply Schoolwear in Greenfield.

School Bags, Make up, Jewellery, Nail Polish and Hairstyles

School bags should be a plain black backpack or messenger style bag. A small logo will be permitted. Make up, jewellery, nail polish, false eyelashes and /or acrylic or gel nails are not permitted at all. We appreciate that students may be treated to acrylic/gel nails, false eyelashes for events over the summer, however, they must be removed prior to returning to school in September. Likewise, students may have new piercings over the summer break, again these must be removed prior to returning to school. Any jewellery worn in school will be confiscated for three weeks in line with our school policy.

Students should not return to school with inappropriate hairstyles, hair must be of one colour, natural in appearance. Hairstyles must not be below a number two and there should be no patterns/lines shaved into the hair. Hair accessories including headscarves, need to be purple or black. Hair bobbles must not be worn around wrists. Hair fashion accessories must not be worn.

School Shoes

We would like to remind parents of the footwear which is deemed acceptable and unacceptable. We are giving advance notice so that no family wastes money on footwear that does not comply with our uniform policy. Footwear must not in any way resemble trainers and shoes manufactured by sportswear companies will not be allowed. Canvas or leather converse/vans style pumps will not be allowed nor will any footwear that covers the

Equipment

It is essential that all students bring the correct equipment into school each and every day and we want to inform you of what you must bring on to school each day. Coming to school ready to learn is the most important thing that you will do each day. Being ready to learn means that the correct books and equipment must be ready in bags and homework completed in readiness for the lessons that day.

- packed lunch or money for lunch if you haven't topped up on the SchoolGateway app
- their locker key (Please note: Students in year 7 will be issued their key as long as we have received their £5 deposit. If this has not yet been paid, please use SchoolGateway app.
